


Show N Shine

POINTS TO PONDER

We participated in many events this year, Show N' Shines, shows, and put on our annual show. The most important thing we did this year was volunteer some time at the

Food Bank and make a \$1000 donation to them. They turn that \$1000 into \$10,000 worth of food. They support seven parishes and 150 organizations with food programs, they fed 75,000 adults and children in 2018.

For the last three years I have had the privilege of meeting with the Executive Director Martha Marak and presenting our check. They are really blown away that we chose to help them out.. Last year when I met with Martha we talked about how they wish they could expand their capability. She never let on but they were quietly raising funds both nationally and locally to purchase property and expand their mission.. They are currently constructing their new facility off of Mt. Zion Road. They raised all but \$700,000 of the 5.5 million dollars needed for the project. HISTORICALLY SPEAKING


